Frontline Role in responding to Corona Emergencies

- > Established Corona Rescue Helpline 1190.
- > Arranged Corona Training for 1037 Rescuers including 336 of KPK, 557 of Punjab and 144 of Baluchistan.
- > Distributed 50,000 Ration Packs to deserving families.
- > Deployment of Rescue Paramedics at Mayo Hospital, PKLI and RIUT, Rawalpindi for management of Corona patients.
- > Training of EMT's on Donning, Doffing techniques & use of ventilators to deal with serious Corona patients.



Development Initiatives

- > Construction of 80 New Rescue Stations completed under various Development Schemes.
- > Expansion of Emergency Service at Barthi, Fazla Katch, Dijkot, Zahir Pir, Ellahbad, Nokhar & Kartarpur Corridor was initiated.
- > After successful implementation of Motorbike Ambulance Service Project in 9 Divisional Headquarters of Punjab, the Government of the Punjab approved the expansion of Motorbike Ambulance Service in remaining 27 Districts of Punjab.
- > 1165 Rescuers recruited for Patient Transfer Service and for expansion of the Service at Tehsil level.



National Rescue Challenge

- > 9th National Rescue Challenge organized at Emergency Services Academy
- > 15 teams participated and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Peshawar Rescue Team won the challenge,
- > Rescue Team Rawalpindi and Gujrat received runner up trophy by getting equal marks in the National competition





National Community Emergency Response Teams Challenge

- > 4th Community Emergency Response Teams (CERTs) Challenge organized at Emergency Services Academy
- > 38 Community Teams participated
- > District Layyah CERT Team won the challenge
- > District Multan remained runner up and District Kasur CERT received 3rd position in the challenge



Community Safety Program - 2020

- > Established over 5000 CERTs in all Union Councils of Punjab.
- > During COVID-19, Rescue Scouts assisted in 50,000 Ration Packs distribution to deserving families.
- > Organized Training of Trainers (TOT) for Rescue Safety Officers on water Sanitation & Hygiene in collaboration with VSO Pakistan.
- > Distributed Disaster Response Kits to Community Emergency Response Teams of Dist. Jhang and Multan
- > Total over 150,000 Community members have been trained in 2020.

- > 30 Rescue Employees were nominated for Hajj Mission 2020 but couldnot go due to COVID-19


